October 1654

Fr. Médaille is transferred to the College of Montferrand. He was aged 44 at this time. He had a great gift for missionary work. His superiors said "He was a born missionary."

This was the time when rural missions were at their peak for the Jesuits. Fr.
Médaille was a great mission preacher.

Read and re-read them often with profound attention, weighing even their least words. There are very few words that do not have their own special meaning and that do not shed new light on truths which they explain...






