#### October 1654

Fr. Médaille is transferred to the College of Montferrand. He was aged 44 at this time. He had a great gift for missionary work. His superiors said "He was a born missionary."

This was the time when rural missions were at their peak for the Jesuits. Fr.
Médaille was a great mission preacher.





After his long and arduous years, travelling the mountainous region, in both good and bad weather, his health, which was never good, began to show signs of weakness.



In Autumn 1669 Fr. Médaille's health was failing and he was relieved of his work on the missions. He was sent to the Jesuits retirement home in Billom.




He had always travelled on foot or on horseback.



His BURIAL PLACE is not known, though it is believed he may have been buried under the ancient chapel – we see the entrance to this chapel in the photo.

Others believe he may have been buried in the College garden, where many of the Fathers were buried.



In many ways Fr. Médaille could have faded into obscurity at the end of his life. Yet, after more than 350 years, he is remembered by thousands of people around the world.

Sisters, Associates, Little Design Communities and Friends of the St Joseph Family are proud of this great man, who has passed on to us such a rich spiritual heritage.


